The Government of Meghalaya, Finance (Pay Revision) Department, vide its O.M. No.F(PR)-69/97/113 Dtd. Shillong the 10th October, 2007 having sanctioned the Dearness Allowance to the State Employees of Meghalaya, w.e.f. 01-07-2007, I am, therefore, to authorise you to make payment of this revised rate of Dearness Allowance to the serving Employees of the Government of Meghalaya, w.e.f. 01-07-2007 at the rate shown at para. 3 below, by production of Bills in respect cases of the Officers concerned, without insisting on individual Authority from this Office. This present rate of Dearness Allowance is inclusive of the rate of Dearness Allowance sanctioned earlier vide Finance (PR) Department, Meghalaya O.M. No.F(PR).69/97/109 Dtd. 29th March, 2007 and authorised vide this office General Authority No.MG.1/DA.ETC/2006-07/OUT/25-37 Dtd. 16th April, 2007.

2. This Authority remains valid till payslip(s) incorporating the present Dearness Allowance is/are issued by this office in respective cases of the officers.
