**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**Sub: Grant of Interim Relief to the State Government Employees/Pensioners.**

The Fourth Meghalaya Pay Commission have recommended the grant of Interim Relief to the State Government Employees including the employees borne on the Work-Charged Establishment and the Aided Educational Institutions under the Deficit Scheme of Grants-in-aid and Casual Employees who are on the regular scales of pay and also the State Government Pensioners and Family Pensioners with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2008 at the rates indicated below :-

| (i)  | Government employees including employees borne on Work-Charged Establishment and Government Aided Educational Institutions and Casual Employees on regular scales of pay (other than Bungalow Peons). | 10% of Basic pay including Dearness Pay subject to minimum of Rs.400/- per mensem.         |
| (ii) | Pensioners and Family Pension Holders.  | 10% of Basic Pension including Dearness Pension subject to minimum of Rs.200/- per mensem. |

2. The Government after due consideration have accepted the above recommendation of the Pay Commission. The Governor of Meghalaya is, therefore, pleased to sanction the Interim Relief at the aforementioned rates to the employees/pensioners indicated under para 1 above with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2008.

3. The amount of Interim Relief will not be termed as pay or pension, as the case may be. Accordingly, the said amount of Interim Relief shall not come for the purposes of computation of Dearness Allowance and compensatory allowance including H.R.A., H.A. etc.

4. The payment on account of Interim Relief shall be rounded off to the nearest Rupee.

5. The Accountant General (A&E), Meghalaya and the authorized Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange payment of the Interim Relief in respect of this State Government employees, Pensioners/Family Pensioners on the basis of the above orders.

6. The expenditure on the account of the payment of the Interim Relief herein sanctioned shall be debitable to the respective heads of Account from which the employees/pensioners draw their salaries/pension.


